TERMS & CONDITIONS OF THE AUCTION

1. Govt. Servants and private individuals are eligible to participate in the bidding process,
2. Bidders will have to deposit bid Security of Rs. 20,000/- (as per EMD fixed for each vehicle) may in the form of Demand Draft/Pay orders in favour of Director Hospitality Chandigarh Administration for being eligible to participate in the auction.
3. Reserve price of the vehicles are as under:-

The successful bidder will have to deposit 25% of the total successful bid amount on the spot and the balance amount i.e 75% will have to be deposit within 72 hours, from the date of auction otherwise, their Earnest Money deposited shall be forfeited or watch and ward charges/penalties (if any) as applicable will be charged extra, before delivery of auctioned vehicles.
5. The successful bidder have to remove the vehicles at his own cost within three days of final payment, failing which resale of the vehicle will be undertaken at the risk and cost of the defaulter
6. The successful bidder will have to pay Govt. Taxes/duties levies extra as applicable on actual basis on the vehicle purchased by him/her. The bidders are hereby also informed that the vehicles will be allowed to be lifted only AS ON WHERE AS BASIS after completing all Govt., formalities and no guarantee for its worthiness or quality will be given by the Hospitality Department.
7. In case, the vehicles purchased by the bidder during auction is not lifted within one-month from the date of auction, total amount deposited with department shall be forfeited.
8. The bidder will have to produce/submit Identity proof and Pan card before starting the auction.

9. The Auction Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any bid without assigning any reasons.
10. All the terms and conditions related to auction will also be announced before the start of auction, on the spot.
11. The Earnest Money to the successful bidder will be released only after the deposit of sale proceeds. Earnest Money will be forfeited if he fails to honour the bid.
12. The delivery of the sold vehicle will be arranged only after the successful bidder submits documentary evidence in support of residential status viz. Ration Card/Voter Identity Card/Passport in case of individual and Registration Certificate in case of firm etc.
13. The successful bidder will also be responsible for getting the Registration Certificate of the vehicle transferred in his name at their own cost expeditiously. The Department will not be responsible for any lapse on his part in this regard.
14. The bidders will not be allowed to withdraw their bids, failing which their Earnest Money will be forfeited.
15. The undersigned reserves the right to accept or reject any/all of the quotations without assigning any reason.
16. Staff and officers of Hospitality Department are not eligible to participate in the bidding process.

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
