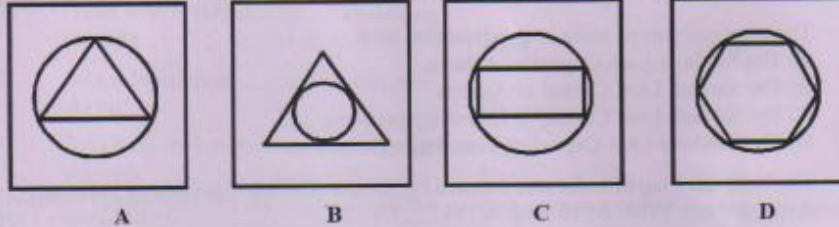

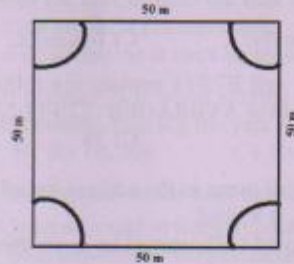

A candidate who creates disturbance of any kind or changes his/her seat, or is found in possession of any paper possibly of any assistance, or found giving or receiving assistance, or found using any other unfair means during the examination will be expelled from the examination. The decision of the Observer shall be final.
14. The candidates will not be allowed to leave the Examination Hall before the expiry of time.
