The Chandigarh Administration, Land Acquisition Branch pronounced the award qua the land acquired for "Construction of Connectivity from Dakshin Marg to P.R. 4 Road U.T./ Punjab Boundary" as per the approved Master plan in the Union Territory of Chandigarh, by acquiring land for the said purpose at Village Dadu Majra, Hadbast No. 14 & Dhanas Hadbast No. 15, Distt. & Tehsil Chandigarh. A notification U/s 4(A) of "The Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency of Land Acquisition Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act 2013" was issued vide notification no. 43/3/327-UTFI(5)-2018/8575 dated 11.06.2018 to conduct Social Impact Assessment. The substance of the notification was published in three daily newspapers i.e. "The Hindustan Times" (English) "Rozana Spokesman" (Punjabi), "Amar Ujjala" (Hindi) on dated 14.06.2018. The Social Impact Assessment was conducted by Punjab University, Chandigarh and further examined by the Expert Group.

The Chandigarh Administration has examined and approved the recommendations of the Expert Group. A notification under section 11 of "The Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act 2013" vide notification no. 43/3/327-UTFI(5)-2018/21745 dated 28.11.2018 and published in Official Gazette on dated 28.11.2018.

According to this notification 5.57 Acres of land in village Dhanas, Hadbast No. 15 and 12.23 Acres of land in village Dadu Majra Hadbast No. 14 i.e. a total of 17.80 Acres has been proposed for acquisition.
