Whereas the Chandigarh Administration, Local Government Department in exercise of the powers conferred under Sub Section (2) of Section 401 of the Punjab Municipal Corporation Act, 1976 as extended to Union Territory, Chandigarh by the Punjab Municipal Law (Extension to Chandigarh) Act, 1994 (Act No. 45 of 1994), published the draft amendment proposed to be made in the Chandigarh Water Supply Bye-Laws, 2011 (as amended from time to time), vide Notification No. 6/1/195-FII(8)-2018/21738, dated 27.11.2018 and inviting objections and suggestions from the general public within a period of 15 days from the date of publication of the said Notification in the gazette of Chandigarh Administration.

And whereas only one objection was received during the stipulated period of 15 days, which was examined by the committee of Executive Engineers and the said Committee recommended that the objection is not sustainable.

Now, therefore in exercise of the exercise of the powers conferred under Section 399 & 401 of the Punjab Municipal Corporation Act, 1976 as extended by the Punjab Municipal Corporation Law (Extension to Chandigarh) Act, 1994 (Act No. 45 of 1994), the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh is pleased to make the following amendments in the Chandigarh Water Supply Bye-Laws 2011 (as amended from time to time).

**BYE-LAWS**

**Short Title:-**

1. These Bye-laws may be called the Chandigarh Water Supply Bye-laws, Amendment 2019.
2. These shall come into force from the date of its publication in official gazette.
3. In the Chandigarh Water Supply Bye-Laws 2011 as amended in 2016 (hereinafter referred to as said bye laws) for clause 10 the following shall be substituted as under:

**Clause No. 10: Connection Pipeleakage of water line between ferrule to water meter:-**

On observing leakage on such points, notice will be served to the consumer asking him/her to get the leakage rectified within a period of 2 days. In case of non compliance,
