## ORDER

No.HIII(5)/2020/ 45/4
Dated 18/04 2020

WHEREAS vide order No.40-3/2020-DM-I(A), dated 24/03/2020, the Union Home Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India had issued an order under Section 10(2)(1) of Disaster Management Act, stipulating lockdown measures for containment of COVID-19 in the country.

WHEREAS the same order was extended vide letter dated 14/04/2020 to remain in force till 3<sup>rd</sup> May, 2020 all over the country.

WHEREAS vide order dated 15/04/2020 it was stipulated by Government of India that additional activities allowed to mitigate hardship of public will not be applicable in containment zone (except those activities, as are specifically permissible under guidelines of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India.)

WHEREAS vide letter No.Z-21020/16/2020-PH, dated 15/04/2020, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare included Chandigarh in the official list of HOTSPOTS (RED ZONE) in the country.

WHEREAS the cases of outbreak of COVID-19 in Chandigarh are seen as scattered, non-contiguous and sporadic in nature and spread

WHEREAS in consultation with the medical experts, the Chandigarh Administration is of considered opinion that the entire city of Chandigarh needs to be kept under stricter measures for containment of spread of COVID-19.

Therefore, the undersigned, in his capacity as Chairperson of State Executive Committee of State Disaster Management Authority hereby declares the entire Union Territory of Chandigarh as "CONTAINMENT ZONE".

Further, it is ordered that the lockdown measures as stipulated in the order dated 14/04/2020 of Ministry of Home Affairs will continue to remain in force upto 03<sup>rd</sup> May, 2020 and **no additional relaxation** whatsoever will be permitted.

All offices of Union Government/State Government, UT Administration/Local Government/Autonomous bodies etc. located within the Union Territory of Chandigarh will continue to strictly observe the lockdown measures, as ordered by Government of India on 14/04/2020.

Further, the **curfew** orders issued by the District Magistrate, Chandigarh will continue to be in force and any violation of the same will be punishable under the law.

The above order will come into force with immediate effect and will remain valid till the midnight of 3<sup>rd</sup> of May, 2020.
