h) Strategies to be adopted by Chandigarh Housing Board



i) Strategies to be adopted by Rural Development Department

The Department shall motivate village Panchayats to plant and protect tree saplings in and around the villages to improve the environmental ambience.

II) ORGANISATIONAL ASPECTS Sapling Distribution

Forest Department is having following 6 (six) nurseries from where free of cost plant saplings may be collected by citizens of chandigarh, NGO's, Schools and other institutions.
