

#### **CHAPTER-II**

#### **REVIEW OF GREENING CHANDIGARH ACTION PLAN 2014-15**

#### TARGETS. ACHIEVEMENTS & OTHERS ACTIVITIES.

Chandigarh Administration reiterates its commitment towards greener and cleaner Chandigarh. The hard work supplemented by sustained campaign and much needed technical inputs have yielded commendable results.

During the year 2014-15, Forest department have achieved 100% plantation targets. During the year 55,000 (No. of Saplings), 1,00,000 no. of stem cutting of Arundo-donax (a soil binder plant) and Ipomea and 3,00,000 number of Patch-sowing were planted as per details given in Table-1.

It will not be out of place to mention that the institutions namely Forest Department, Municipal Corporation, Engineering

Department, Punjab Agriculture University-Chandigarh, NGOs, Resident Welfare Associations, Educational Institutions and above all, the strong will and farsightedness of the Administration contributed a lot towards the success of this programme. The contribution, dedications and genuine concern of the proud citizens of the 'City Beautiful' to make the city greener needs special mention. Encouraged by the previous year's results, the Forest Department in collaboration with Municipal Corporation and Engineering Department had chalked out a programme to continue the efforts with the renewed zeal during year 2014-15. An exhaustive and comprehensive plantation plan for the year 2014-15 was prepared.
