


STATE BIRD OF CHANDIGARH

The Indian Grey Hombill (Ocyceros birostris) is a common hombill found in Chancigam. It is mostly anomeal and is commonly sighted in pairs. They have grey feathers all over the body with a light grey or dull white belly. The hom is black or dark grey with a casque extending up to the point of curvature in the hom. They are one of the few hombill spocies found within urban areas in many cities where they are able to make use of large avenue trees. It is declared as the state bird of the Chandigarh during the year 2009.
