To fulfill this requirement, and also to make up for the shortage of faculty we have visiting faculty from amongst the professionals in the city. The detailed current faculty position is given in the enclosed statement.

Physical Facilities and Infrastructure: The college is well endowed with essential physical facilities viz. boys and girls hostel, an airconditioned assembly hall (180 capacity), 2 Audio Visual Lecture Room(Capacity 30 to 40) and 3 class rooms with capacity of 30 each a centrally air-conditioned library with approximately 15,500 volumes, an audio-visual section with all essential equipment, a photography laboratory with facilities for processing black and white photographs, a carpentry/model making workshops, and a museum displaying building materials with all the structural, services and construction models, teaching-aids, models, etc. There is also a 41-seater college bus for short and long study tours. Adequate facilities for sports, a well equipped gymnasium, and art club and facilities for other extracurricular activities also exist. The college had made significant progress in setting up a Computer Aided Design Laboratory, which is progressively being enlarged and upgraded.

Activities to enrich Curriculum: Special lectures by eminent architects and allied professionals, workshops, seminars/presentations are planned and conducted throughout the academic year as ongoing activities. Study tours by teachers and students are an important aspect of our training. Our students also participate actively in the national level, bi-annual conventions of students of architecture.
