## ORDER

No. 13180-HIII(5)/2022/2410 Chandigarh, dated the 1002 2022

Further to order No. 13180-HIII(5)/2022/71 dated 03/01/2022, order No. 13180-HIII(5)/2022/295 dated 06/01/2022, order No. 13180-HIII(5)/2022/1509 dated 27/01/2022 and order No. 13180-HIII(5)/2022/2064 dated 03/02/2022, it is hereby ordered as under:-

- The restrictions on movement of individuals from 12:30 A.M. to 5.00 A.M. for all the non-essential activities are removed.
- ii) Schools and coaching institutions will be allowed to start functioning with full capacity in hybrid (offline/online mode) for all classes w.e.f. 14.02.2022. However, the detailed order in this regard will be issued by the Secretary Education, Chandigarh Administration, separately.
- iii) The Chandigarh Bird Park and Rock Garden will be allowed to open w.e.f. 12.02.2022.
- iv) All restrictions due to COVID on Markets, Shops, April Mandis, Establishments, Malls, Restaurants, Hotels, Bars, Cinema Halls, Multiplexes, Museums, Sports Complexes, Swimming pools, Gyms, Spas and Health Centres are removed expect the following:-
  - (a) Gathering for any purpose should be restricted to 200 persons indoor and 500 persons for outdoor. However, the total number of persons shall not exceed 50% of the capacity in both indoor and outdoor gatherings.

This order shall come into force with effect from 11/02/2022 and will be applicable until further orders.

Any breach of this order shall invite action under section 51 to 60 of the Disaster management Act, 2005 and Section 188 of the Indian Penal Code alongwith other applicable laws.
