In continuation of this Ministry's O.M. of even number dated 17.05.2018 and consequent upon the decision taken by the Government on the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission (CPC), the approval of Competent Authority is conveyed for payment of HPCA/PCA to all Group 'A' & 'B' (Non-ministerial employees) Allied Healthcare Professionals excluding Nurses working in various Central Government Healthcare Facilities as per cell R1H3 of the Risk and Hardship Matrix, if underlying conditions of their exposure as per this Ministry's letter No. Z.28015/24/2001-H dated 04.02.2004 are satisfied, in the following manner:


S. No.	Level of Pay Scale	Rate of amount of HPCA/PCA admissible per month
1.	Level 8 and below	Rs. 4,100/-
2.	Level 9 and above	Rs. 5,300/-

2. This is also subject to the following conditions:

- HPCA/PCA may be admissible in case the individual proceeds on leave/training for less than one calendar month.
- HPCA/PCA may not be admissible in case of the individual proceeds on leave/training for equivalent and more than one calendar month.
- HPCA/PCA should not be admissible in case of unauthorized leave.

3. This order shall be effective from 1st July, 2017.



Subject: **Recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission-
Revision of rates of Annual Allowance in respect of Central
Health Service Officers.**

The undersigned is directed to refer to the subject cited above and to say that the Seventh Central Pay Commission has recommended to raise Annual Allowance by 50 percent. The amount will further rise by 25 percent each time DA rises by 50 percent. Consequent upon acceptance of recommendations of the Seventh Central Pay Commission by the Government, the President is pleased to decide that hereafter the officers of Teaching, Non-Teaching, Public Health sub-cadres and General Duty Medical Officers having PG qualification recognized under Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 will be granted Annual Allowance at the rate of Rs. 2250/- p.m. (Rupees Two Thousand Two Hundred and Fifty per month). The General Duty Medical Officers who do not possess any Post Graduate qualification or who may possess unrecognized PG qualification will be granted Annual Allowance at the rate of Rs. 1350/- p.m. (Rupees One Thousand Three Hundred and Fifty per month). These revised rates of Annual Allowance will be subject to the following condition:-

'At the end of financial year, each Specialist/General Duty Medical Officer will be required to furnish a certificate to the effect that the amount of Annual Allowance has been utilized for the purpose it was drawn. In the case of retirement/resignation before the end of the financial year, such a certificate will be furnished at the time of such retirement/resignation.'

2. The rates of these allowances will be increased by 25 % each time the Dearness Allowance payable on revised pay scale rises by 50 %.
3. This order will take effect from 01.07.2017.

Implementation of the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission
regarding

Consequent upon the decision taken by the Government of India on the recommendations of the 7th Pay Commission, the President is pleased to sanction the revision of existing rate of Nursing allowance to the Nursing Personnel of all categories at all levels working in Central Government/ UT Hospitals/ Institutions and Centrally funded autonomous Bodies like AIIMS, New Delhi, PGIMER, Chandigarh, JIPMER, Pondicherry etc., subject to the following conditions and as per the details given below:

S.No	Allowance	Existing Rates	Revised rate as per 7 th CPC
1.	Nursing allowance	Rs.4800/- per month	Rs.7200/- per month

- (a) Nursing Allowance will not be treated as a part of pay as already decided vide Ministry of Health and Family Welfare Order No. Z-28015/86-97 N dated 28th July, 1998.
- (b) The additional expenditure due to enhancement of Nursing Allowance would be met by the respective institutions from their sanctioned budget.
2. The revised rates of Nursing Allowance shall be admissible with effect from the 1st of July, 2017. The rates of Nursing Allowance will go up by 25% each time the Dearness Allowance payable on revised pay scale rises by 50%.
3. Nursing Allowance will be payable to all Nurses whether working in Dispensaries or in Hospitals.
4. This issues with the approval of SS&FA vide Dy.No.2897/17-IFD dated 10.08.2017 and Department of Expenditure vide ID Note No.300347605/2017 dated 24.08.2017.

Subject: Dress Allowance to the Nursing Personnel - Implementation of the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission - regarding

Consequent upon the decision taken by the Government of India on the recommendations of the 7th Pay Commission, in supersession of the existing orders relating to Uniform allowance and Washing Allowance, which have been subsumed in a single Dress Allowance, the President is pleased to decide the rates of Dress Allowance at the rate of Rs.1800/- per month in respect of the Nursing Personnel of all categories at all levels working in Central Government/ UT Hospitals/ Institutions and Centrally funded autonomous bodies like AIIMS, New Delhi, PGIMER, Chandigarh, JIPMER, Pondicherry etc., subject to the following conditions.

1. Allowance related to washing of Uniform are subsumed in Dress Allowance and will not be payable separately.
2. The amount of Dress Allowance shall be credited to the salary of the employees from 1st July, 2017.

3. The Dress Allowance shall be treated as a part of pay as already decided vide Ministry of Health and Family Welfare Order No. Z-28015/86/97-N dated 10.08.2017.

4. The Dress Allowance will go up by 25% each time Dearness Allowance rises by 25%.

5. The revised rates of allowances shall be admissible with effect from the 1st of July, 2017.

6. The additional expenditure on this allowance would be met by the respective institutions from their sanctioned budget.

7. This issues with the approval of SSGPA vide Dy.No.2807/17510 dated 10.08.2017 and Department of Expenditure vide ID Note No.300347505/2017 dated 14.08.2017.

Subject:- Revision of rates of Operation Theatre allowance (Special allowance) to the Nursing Personnel working in Central Government Hospitals as per recommendations of the 7th CPC - regarding

Consequent upon the decision taken by the Government of India on the recommendations of the 7th Pay Commission, the President is pleased to revise the rate of Operation Theatre allowance (Special allowance renamed as Operation Theatre allowance) from Rs.360/- per month to Rs.540/- per month to the Nursing Personnel working in the following specialized areas in Central Government Hospitals/ Institutions under the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare :-

- All Major Operation Theatres
- All Intensive Care Units/ Intensive Care Treatment areas
- Coronary Care Units/ Cardiac Catheterization Laboratories
- Dialysis Unit/ Ward and Transplant Units/ Wards
- Intensive Care Units for Burns
- Tetanus Wards and Rabies Wards
- Paediatric Nursery/ Neonatal Units

Operation Theatre allowance admissible to nursing personnel is subject to the following conditions:

- The allowance shall be paid to the nursing personnel for such period only when the concerned staff is actually working in the specified areas. The minimum period for working in the specialized areas will be two to three years.
 - No Nursing Officer with less than one year of service is to be posted for duty in these areas.
 - This allowance is restricted to 35% of the total staff strength of nursing staff of any hospital/ Institution.
- The revised rates of allowances shall be admissible with effect from the 1st of July, 2017.
 - This issues with the approval of Deptt of Expenditure vide ID No.A.27023/1/2017/E.II.B(7th CPC)/Pt. dated 14.09.2017.

Office Memorandum

Subject: **Revision of rates of Non-Practising Allowance (NPA) in respect of medical posts other than the posts included in the Central Health Services-recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission.**

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Ministry's OM No. 7(19)/2008-E-III.A dated 30.8.2008 regarding the existing rates of Non-Practising Allowance (NPA) admissible to medical posts other than the posts included in the Central Health Services and to say that as provided for in para 7 of this Ministry's Resolution No. 1-2/2016-IC dated 25th July, 2016, the question of revision of rates of allowances (except Dearness Allowance) based on the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission was referred to a Committee under the Chairmanship of Finance Secretary and until a final decision thereon, all allowances were required to be paid at the existing rates in the existing pay structure (the pay structure based on 6th Pay Commission) as if the pay has not been revised w.e.f. 1st January, 2016. Accordingly, NPA was also required to be paid at the existing rates specified in the aforesaid OM dated 30.8.2008.


2. The decisions of the Government on the revised rates of various allowances based on the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission and in the light of the recommendations of the Committee under the Chairmanship of the Finance Secretary have since been notified as per the Resolution No. 11-1/2016-IC dated 6th July, 2017.

3. Accordingly, the President is pleased to decide that in modification of the existing rates of NPA as contained in the aforesaid OM dated 30.8.2008, the NPA shall now be paid at the rate of 20% of the basic pay in the revised pay structure in vogue based on the recommendations of the 7th Central Pay Commission, as contained in the CCS(RP) Rules, 2016, subject to the condition that the sum of basic pay and NPA does not exceed Rs. 2,37,500 (Rupees two lakh thirty seven thousand and five hundred only). The following conditions shall regulate the grant of NPA under these orders:

- (i) The term "basic pay" in the revised pay structure shall mean "basic pay" as defined in Rule 3(x) of CCS(RP) Rules, 2016, i.e., "basic pay" in revised pay structure means the pay drawn in the prescribed Level in the Pay Matrix.
- (ii) The NPA shall continue to be treated as pay for the purpose of computation of Dearness Allowance and other allowances, except those allowances in respect of which the applicable orders provide otherwise, including calculation of retirement benefits. Dearness Allowance under these orders shall mean dearness allowance as sanctioned by the Central Government from time to time in the 7th Pay Commission-related pay structure.
- (iii) NPA shall continue to be restricted to those medical posts for which medical qualifications recognised under the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 or under the Dentist Act, 1948 have been prescribed as an essential qualification. The following conditions shall also be fulfilled as hitherto:-
 - (a) The post is a clinical one.
 - (b) The post is a whole time post.
 - (c) There is ample scope for private practice, and
 - (d) It is necessary to prohibit private practice in public interest.



- 4 The revised rate of NPA in terms of these orders shall take effect from 1st July, 2017.
- 5 In respect of medical posts under the Ministries of Railways, Defence and Department of Atomic Energy, separate orders will be issued by the concerned administrative authorities in these Ministries.
